Elections 2023: Three city council at-large* seats are up for grabs this November. All three incumbents are running for re-election and have one or more challengers. Now is the time to start understanding the record and positions of the incumbents and to learn about the background and positions of the challengers. The HNA will be hosting a candidate forum at the International Community School on issues important to Houghton residents.

LaQuinta Update: The lack of activity at the La Quinta after the long and contentious process with the city and King County is notable. We learned recently that the City's human services team has been working with King County on a referral network process over the past two months and that the lack of visible construction activity stems from the fact King County has yet to file construction permits with the City.

Houghton Village Update: HNA has been communicating with the City around activating the Houghton Village site to engage the neighborhoods surrounding Houghton Center this summer. There were various suggestions made by city council members and neighbors on how to do this immediately after the purchase. The City's current plan is to focus on trying to get new tenants into the empty store spots as a first priority (Studio East) and outreach to surrounding businesses. There is no development partner at this time nor active plans for this summer.

We encourage all residents to remain active and vocal about their preferences for the development of the Houghton Village site as the City is still in planning phases.

As property owners **we are responsible** for the walkability of the sidewalks on the perimeters of our property. Now is the time to check that your sidewalks are tidy and clear of obstructions. If you see areas that need attention, there are two things you can do: alert the owner personally or create an *Our Kirkland* service request. The city will reach out to the resident, remind them of the obligation and give them a timeline to remedy the situation per city code.

Fire Station 22 Update: On-time and on-budget, Chief **Joe Sanford** explained the station will be ready for operation in August with a ribbon cutting ceremony in September. Twenty new recruits will be hired by August, trained and online by January of 2024. HNA extended a word of gratitude for the KFD and BFD response to the large home fire on 105th recently.

Parks Ballot Measure: The City would like to put a "Levy Lid Lift" on the November 7th 2023 ballot to fund a variety of additional park expenditures including a community pool and recreation facility. The Houghton Park and Ride on 70th is a strong contender for the facility. The sale of the property to the City continues to be "pending."
